- 6. I will comply with the reporting requirements and keep appropriate records through the full term of the agreement of the project, as determined by the SJVAPCD and CARB.
- 7. The maximum eligible incentive amount is based on the cost of the new diesel engine. Funding will cover 85 percent of the eligible cost of the new engine, funding is not to exceed 85 percent of eligible costs. The maximum eligible incentive amount is calculated up to the cost-effectiveness limit, and may not necessarily reflect the maximum funding amount. Additionally, the incentive amount may be reduced after the claim for payment has been finalized, depending on all eligible items invoiced.
