

RAISIN TRAY REBATE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (SJVAPCD) is accepting applications for the ***Non-Combustion Alternatives to Open Burning of Raisin Trays Program (Raisin Tray Rebate Program)***. The Program provides rebates to Valley raisin growers to help support the deployment of non-burning alternatives for the disposition of raisin trays.

Requirements:

- Rebates are available for the disposal of raisin trays at local disposal sites through self-hauling or third-party hauling services.
- Rebates are funded based on the number of acres associated with the raisin tray disposal. The final rebate amount is calculated at the following rates:

Total Farmed Acreage	Rebate
100 acres or less	\$35 per acre of raisin trays
Greater than 100 acres	\$35 per acre up to \$2,000 per applicant

- Rebates are available for the 2023 harvest season to assist in the transition to non-burning alternatives. **Rebate applications will be accepted through March 31, 2024.**
- No portion of the raisin trays can be burned, or disposed of in any type of combustion process, prior to or after submission of the rebate application.
- Waste, other than the raisin trays, **cannot** be included in the waste hauling services being submitted with the rebate application.
- The vineyard associated with the raisin trays must be located within the SJVAPCD boundaries.

Rebate Process:

- Rebate applications will be accepted and funded on a first come, first served basis.
- After the completion of the disposal, applicant may apply for a rebate by submitting a **complete rebate application** to the SJVAPCD which includes all invoices for the hauling and/or disposal services used.
- The SJVAPCD will issue a rebate approximately 60 working days following receipt and verification of a complete rebate packet. The rebate amount **cannot** exceed 100% of the total disposal cost.
- Rebates will be issued pending the availability of funds. The SJVAPCD does not guarantee the availability of rebate funds. **A complete rebate packet must be submitted for rebate consideration.**
